

We are learning to examine the features of informational text.

Informational text is written to give information, The text might be informing, explaining or giving directions.

Making Connections

*Does this remind you of something?
Has something like this ever happened to you?
Is this story similar to another text you have read?*

Questioning

Why did the character do something?
How did it make them feel?
What is the author's intended purpose when writing this text? eg To inform, to entertain or to persuade.

Predicting

Looking at the cover, what do you expect this text to be about?
What do you think will happen next?
What words / images do you expect to see or hear next in the text?

My goal

is to use a range of strategies to read for meaning.

Summarising

Can you retell the story?
eg Who were the main characters, setting and sequence of events?
What did you learn from this informative text?
If you were to tell another person about the text, how would you describe it in a few sentences?

Monitoring

Is this making sense?
Do I need to re-read?
Does it now make sense?

Visualising

Can you describe a picture or image you made in your head when you read the text?
